



Ship Carrying Ukrainian Corn Grounds in Turkey’s Bosphorus Strait

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Update: The M/V Lady Zehma has been refloated and moved to an anchorage. Bosphorus Strait reopened to ship traffic -General Directorate of Coastal Safety

A bulk ship carrying grain from Ukraine ran aground in Turkey’s Bosphorus Strait, halting traffic in the waterway.

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Ship traffic on the Bosphorus has been suspended.

Rescue teams with the General Directorate of Coastal Safety have boarded the ship.

AIS data from [MarineTraffic](#) shows the Panama-flagged ship as “stopped.”

The UN Joint Coordination Centre, which was [set up in Istanbul](#) to oversee Ukrainian grain exports under a UN-brokered deal between Russia and Ukraine, shows the *Lady Zehma* was authorized to depart Ukraine’s Port of Chornomorsk with 3,000 metric tons of corn bound for Ravenna, Italy on August 29.
